I started my career as a Ranger back in 2014 where I completed my Cert III in Land Management out at Myuma Training Camp at Camooweal. I then started with the Lake Eyre Basin Rangers in Longreach. I stayed with that group for two years before accepting a position out at Idalia National Park with the Queensland Parks and Wildlife in which I helped care take a 145,000 hectare National Park and on many occasions care taking by myself. I applied for a Ranger position with the Batavia Traditional Owners Corporation hoping to get on to be able to have the opportunity to work on country, even though not a T.O I treat the country as if my own with care and respect.



Hi, I am Mia-Rose Springhall. I was born in the small city of Hobart, Tasmania and have travelled a lot of Australia. I have been living in Far North Queensland for the past 4 years. I studied Conservation and Land Management and I worked as a Land Protection Officer for 2 years around Mareeba Shire.
